Thought Question:

Paul used two related words in **1:6-7** – “unto another [heteros] gospel: Which is not another [allos]” (KJV). Both words describe distinctiveness, but in two distinct ways – heteros (qualitative – another of a different sort); allos (quantitative – another of the same sort). What does this language, along with the context, tell us about the nature of the gospel and our ability to know whether a message is a part of the gospel?
