4.	What three things will occur because of Babylon's fall? (14:1-2, 3-23, 12-20)
5.	When would Israel be restored to their own land? (cf. Jeremiah 25:11-12; 29:10) Who will be joined with Israel when they are restored to their own land? (14:1-2)
6.	Who is "Lucifer?" (14:4, 12) What does this language indicate? (14:12-15)
7.	What does Assyria's destruction mean for Babylon? (14:24-27)
8.	Why should Philistia not rejoice? (14:28-32)

Is the description of Isaiah 13:10 literal? If not, what is the meaning? How can understanding such language aid us in interpreting passages of judgement in the New Testament? (cf. Matthew 24:29)
