PROVERBS: Parents & Children

INTRODUCTION:

This lesson will consider 29 proverbs giving wisdom for both parents and children in the family relationship. With family turmoil so rampant, these wise proverbs are much needed in our society.

- II. CORRECTIVE DISCIPLINE AND PROPER INSTRUCTION ARE PART OF LOVE FOR A CHILD (13:24, 19:18, 22:6, 22:15, 23:13-14, 29:15, 29:17).
- III. THE SHAME OF MISTREATING PARENTS (19:26, 20:20, 23:22, 28:24).
- IV. THE JOYFUL PRIDE IN A LONG LINE OF OFFSPRING AND ANCESTORS (17:7, 20:7).
