Do We Have the Right to Declare God's Word?

Principle Established

- In alliance with wickedness when tolerating it
 - Saw a thief and consented with him
 - Made a partaker with adulterers
 - How? By tolerating evil rather than rebuking it
- Proverbs speak to the same principle
 - 17:15 Justifying the wicked is abomination
 - 24:24 One covering for wicked will be cursed
 - 28:4 Praising the wicked = Forsaking the law
- Such deception aids wicked (Ezek. 13:22)

In Nations of Israel & Judah

- Rule for any nation: Proverbs 14:34
- Judah allowed it at times (1 Kgs. 14:22-24)
 - Later put it away (1 Kgs. 15:11-12; 22:46)
 - Law accepted **NO** wickedness (*Deut. 23:17*)
- Israel destroyed for continually allowing it (2 Kgs. 17:7-18)
- Death sentence assured "that there be no wickedness among you" (Lev. 20:10-13)

In the Church

- Ideal of purity stated: 2 Cor. 11:2-3
- Cases of immorality tolerated in churches
 - Rev. 2:20-23 Jezebel tolerated at Thyatira
 - 1 Cor. 5:1-13 Puffed up in receiving evil doer
 - 1 Cor. 15:33 Primary application to church
 - Jude 3-4 Contend for the faith with false teachers
- In every case of evil present in any church, the instruction was <u>always</u> to **purge it**
- Evil present is unequal yoke (2 Cor. 6:14f)

In the Family

- Must seek spiritual good of others: 1 Pet. 3
- Acceptance of evil devastates the family
 - *Matthew 5:32*
 - Matthew 19:9
 - Immorality breeds more & more if not rebuked
- Note demands of love (*Rom. 12:9*)
 - "Abhor that which is evil"
 - "Cleave to that which is good"
- No true love present if tolerate immorality

Must Not Conceal Sin, But Must Expose, Rebuke & Purge It

- Dealt with severely in O.T. (*Deut. 13:6-11*)
 - "You shall not consent to him or listen to him"
 - "Nor shall your eye pity him"
 - "Nor shall you spare him or conceal him"
 - "Your hand shall be first against him"
- Same principle seen in N.T.
 - Romans 1:32
 - *Ephesians 5:7-12*

Are We Guilty of Tolerating Evil?

- What do we do when we know of evil...
 - In the society around us?
 - *In the local church?*
 - In our family?
 - In our friends?
- Do we:
 - Consent to the sinner or listen to his complaints?
 - Does our eye pity him & give him sympathy?
 - Do we spare or conceal him from exposure?
- If so, must repent, changing attitude & action

Does God see us as having the right to declare truth?
