# Pursuit Requires Diligent Scrutiny

- Must fulfill responsibilities towards man & God
- Looking carefully for falling short of God's grace
  - *Hebrews 4:1-2* Entire letter deals with theme (*Heb. 6:4-6*)
  - *2 Peter 3:17*
  - *Galatians 5:4*
- Looking carefully for bitterness
  - *James 3:14*
  - *Colossians 3:19*
- Looking carefully for immorality (fleshly lust)
  - *1 Corinthians 6:15-20*
  - *1 Thessalonians 4:1-7*
- Remember: There will be a time when it is too late
