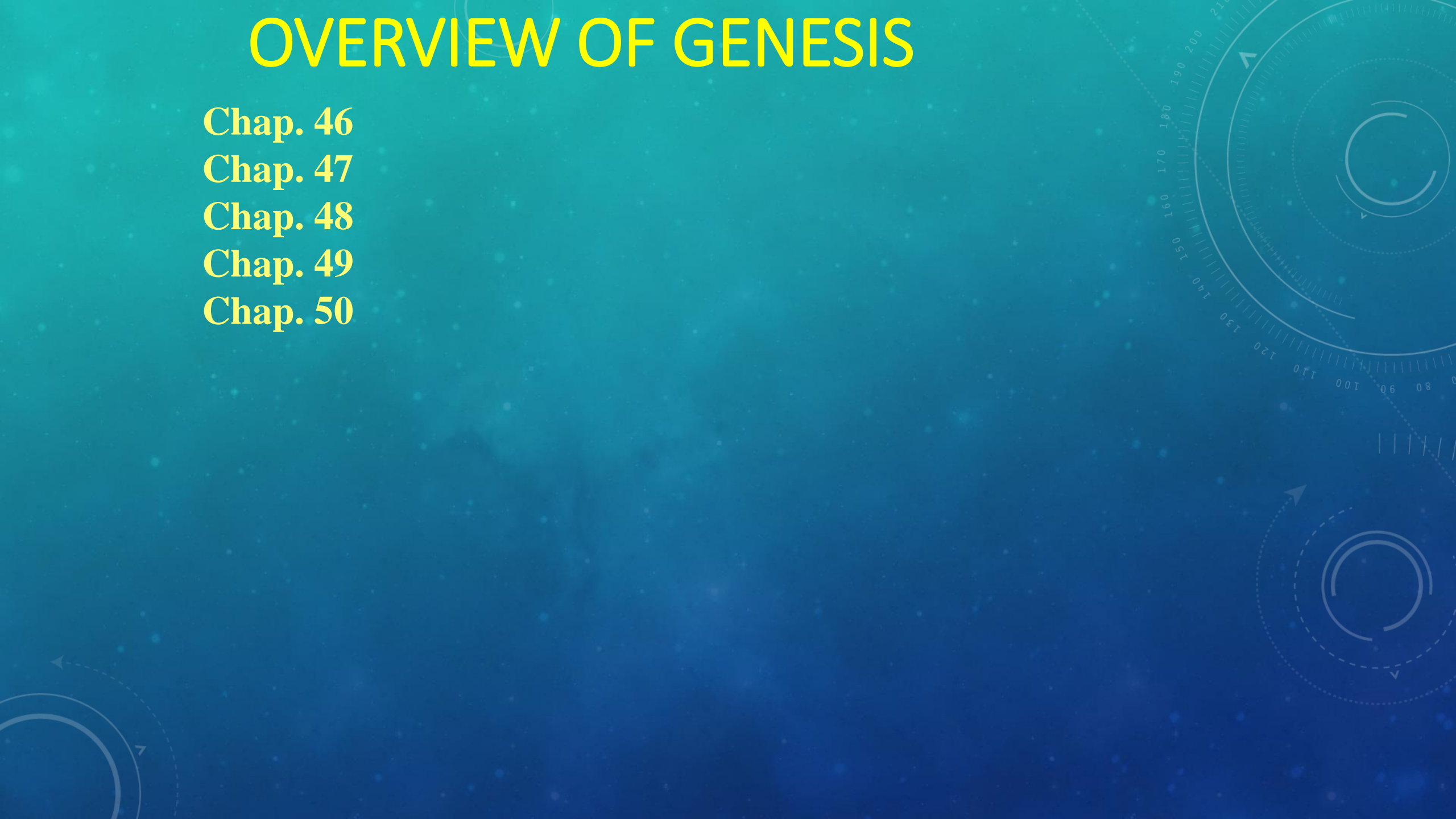

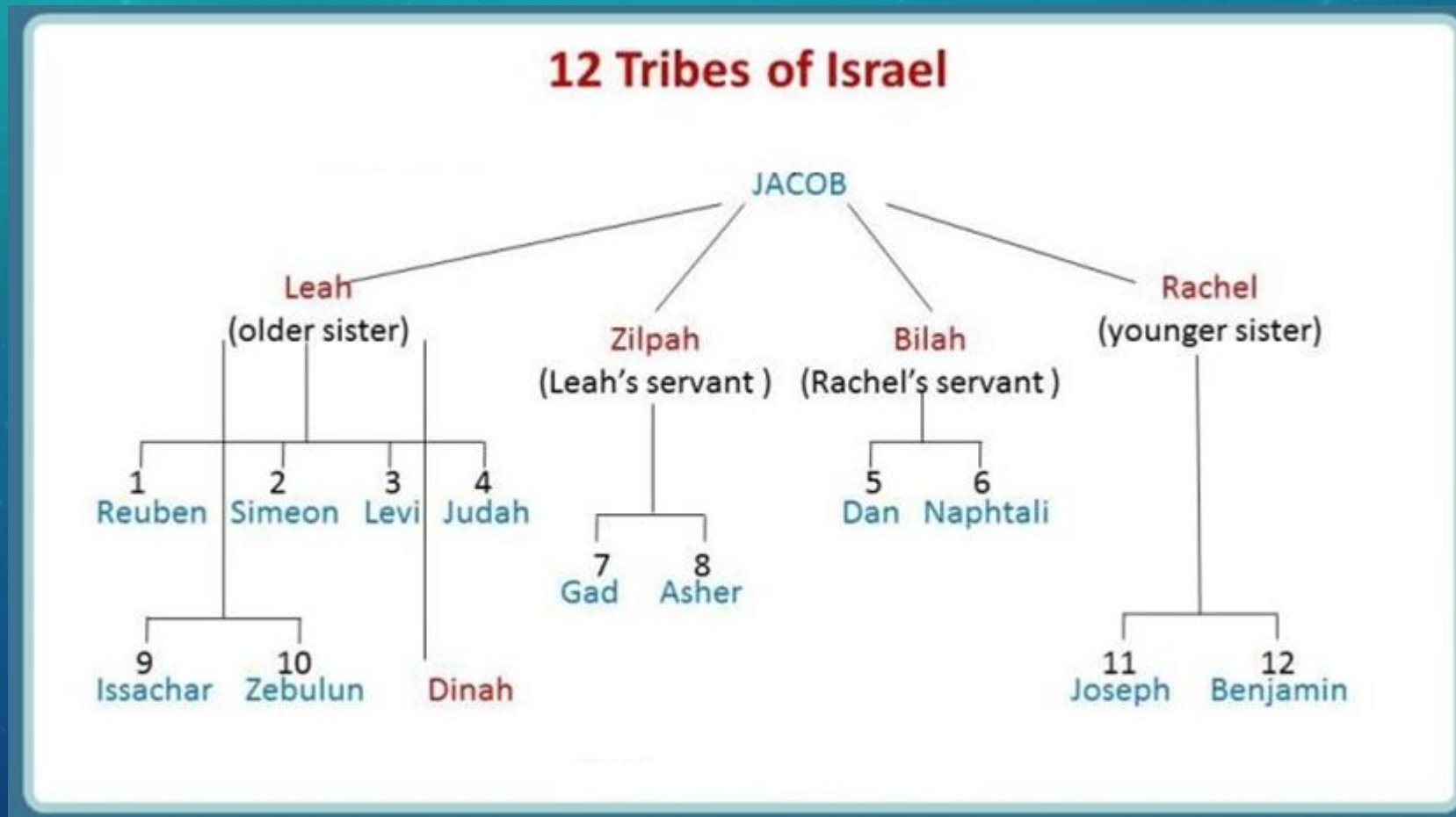

- Jacob / Israel moves his offspring, herds and possessions, stopping in Beersheba





• Chapter 46

- Jacob / Israel moves his offspring, herds and possessions, stopping in Beersheba
- Jacob offers sacrifices to God. God reassures him, making four promises
- The trip continues and Joseph meets Jacob in Goshen in a joyful reunion
- Joseph instructs his brothers to tell Pharaoh that they are shepherds

• Chapter 47

- Pharaoh interviews five brothers and agrees the family should settle in Goshen
- Jacob meets Pharaoh and blesses him. They settle in the land of Rameses
- Joseph continues selling grain in the famine, taking livestock and land
- The famine continues and Joseph buys all the land and people for Pharaoh
- An arrangement is set up; the people work the land and give $1/5^{\text{th}}$ to Pharaoh
- Jacob makes Joseph swear to bury him with his fathers instead of in Egypt

• Chapter 48

- Jacob is on his deathbed and cannot see well
- Jacob adopts and blesses the two sons of Joseph, Manasseh and Ephraim
- Jacob explains the younger son shall be greater than the older

• Chapter 49

- Israel (Jacob) gathers his sons and blesses (?) them before he dies
 - Reuben – unstable
 - Simeon and Levi – angry and violent
 - Judah – a lion and leader
 - Zebulun – dwell by the sea
 - Issachar – will become a servant
 - Dan – a judge and serpent
 - Gad – a raider
 - Asher – a foodie
 - Naphtali – a fruitful doe
 - Joseph – strong, blessed by God
 - Benjamin – a ravenous wolf
- Israel (Jacob) gives final instructions before his death

• Chapter 50

- Israel dies and Joseph has the physicians embalm him
- Pharaoh gives Joseph permission to travel to bury Israel with his family
- “A great company” grieves for Israel at the threshing floor of Atad
- Israel is buried in the cave of the field at Machpelah, to the east of Mamre
- Joseph’s brothers fear his vengeful wrath will surface after their father dies
- Joseph dies and is embalmed and buried in a coffin in Egypt
