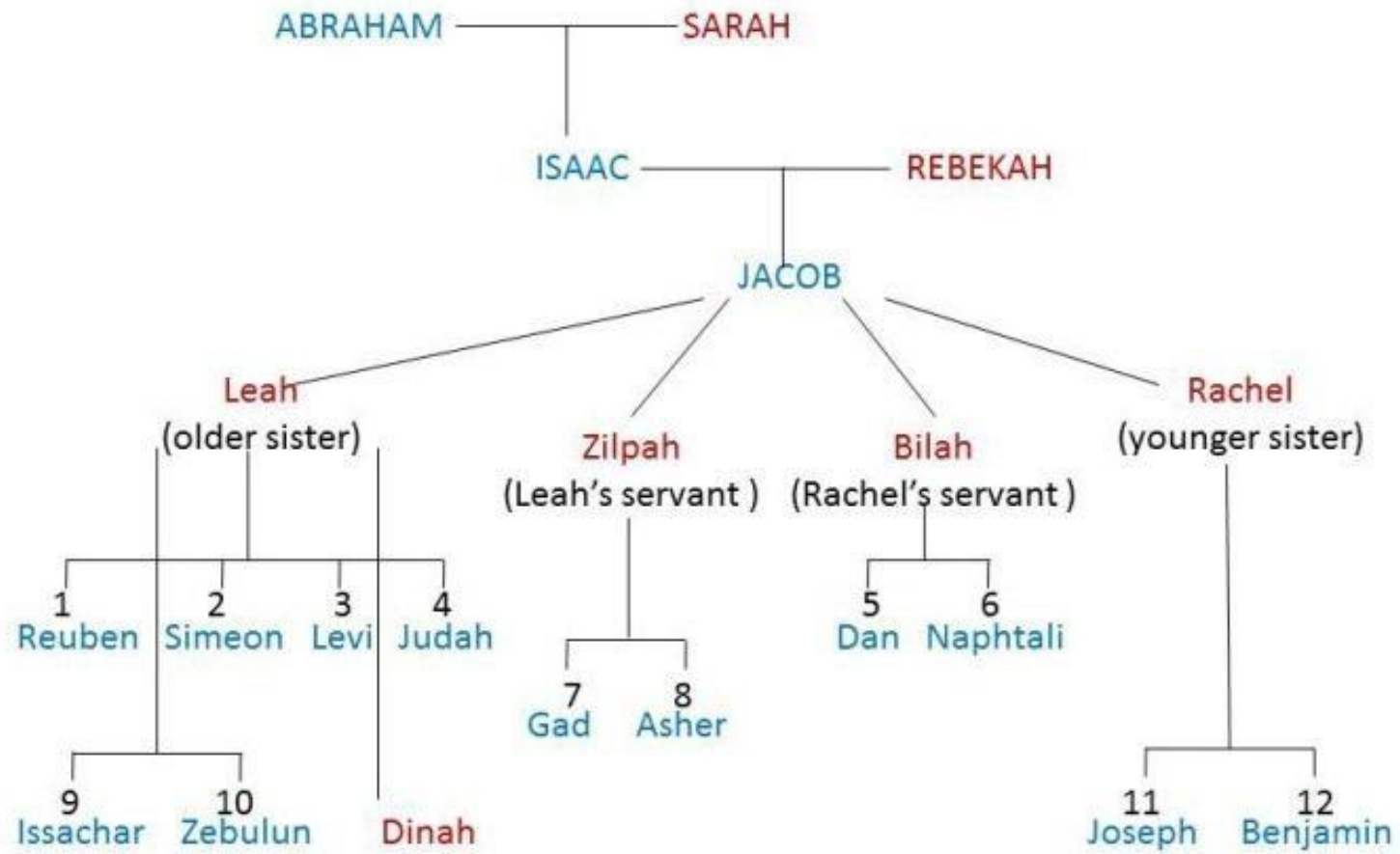

Genesis 10-36 - KJV Spelling

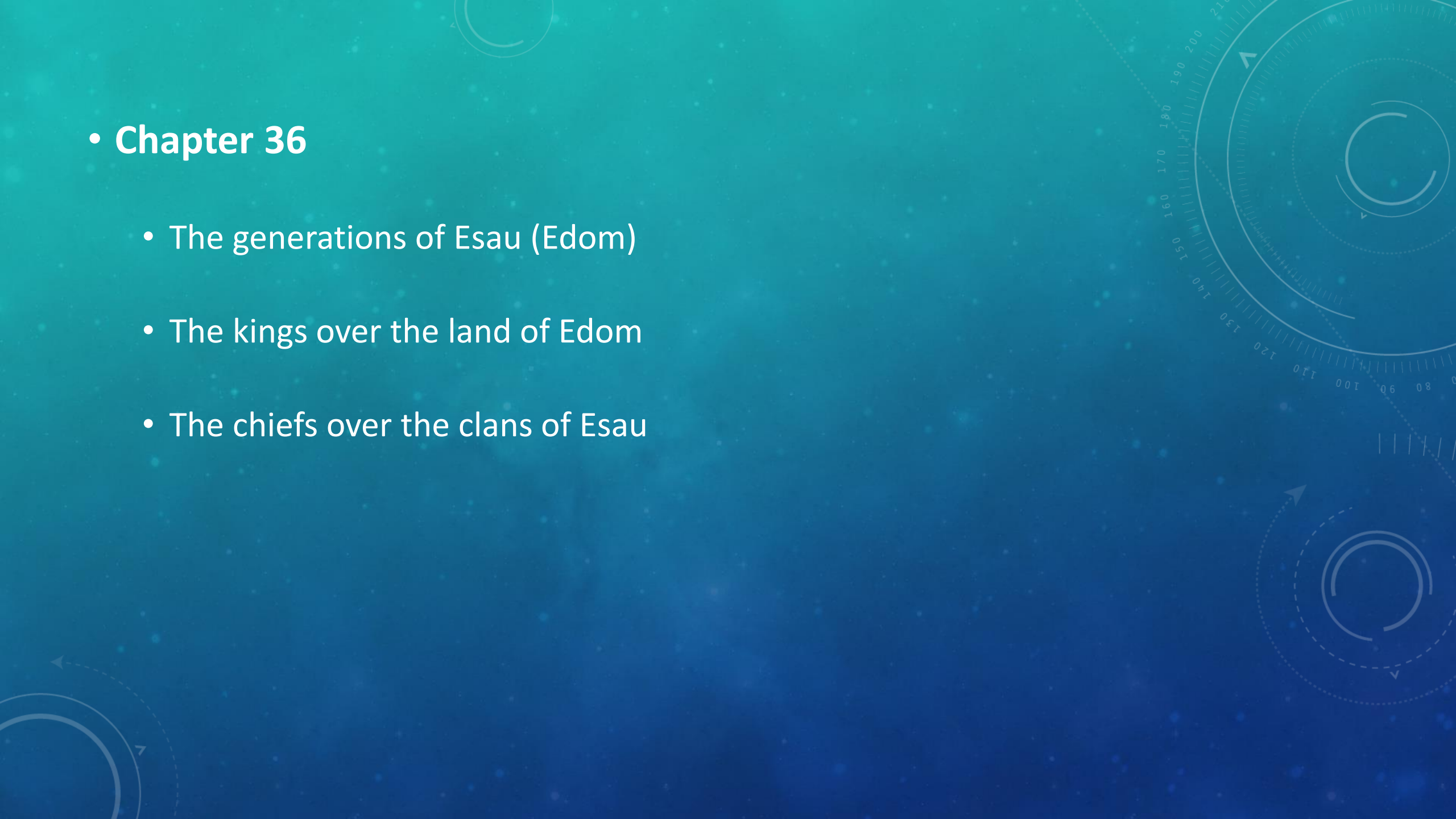

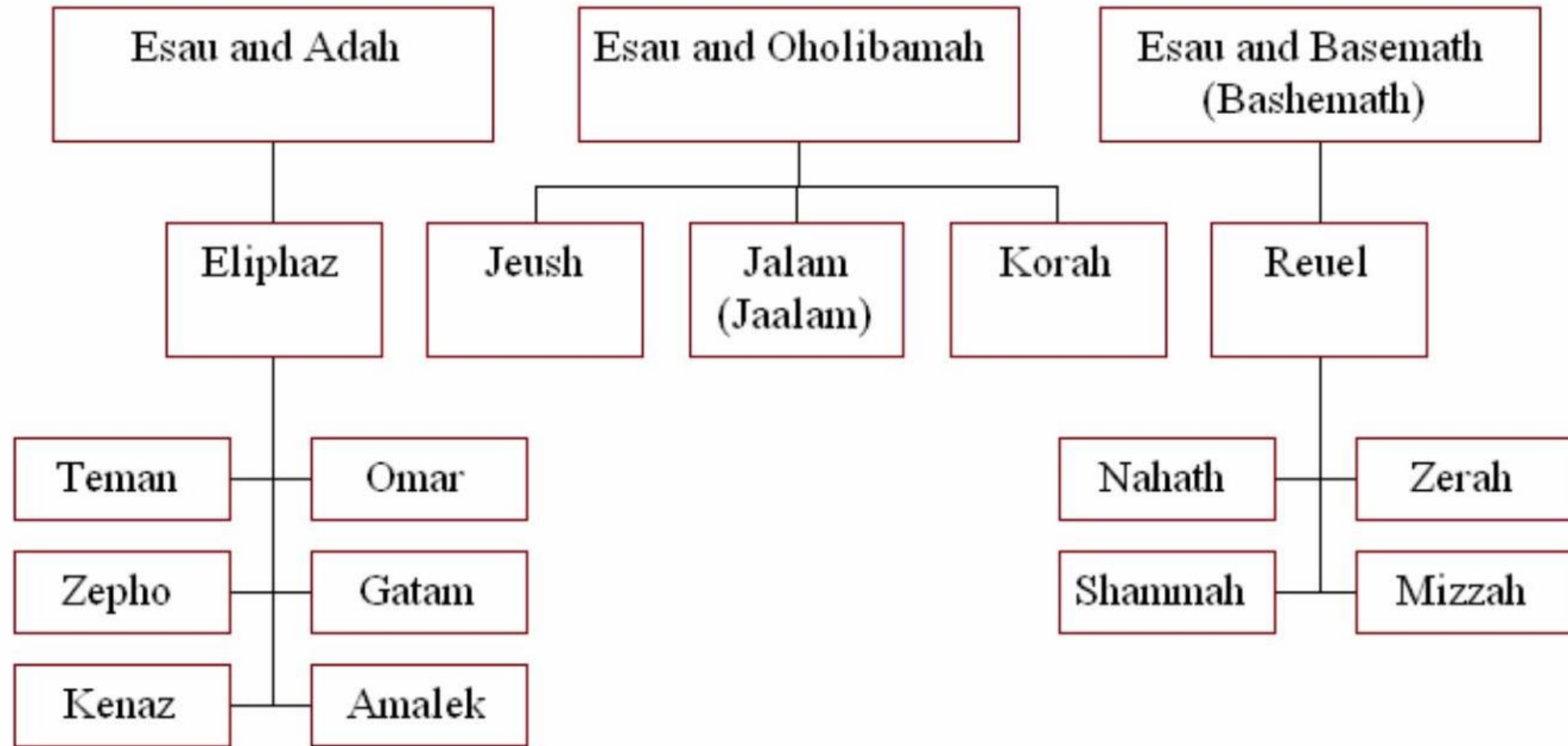
