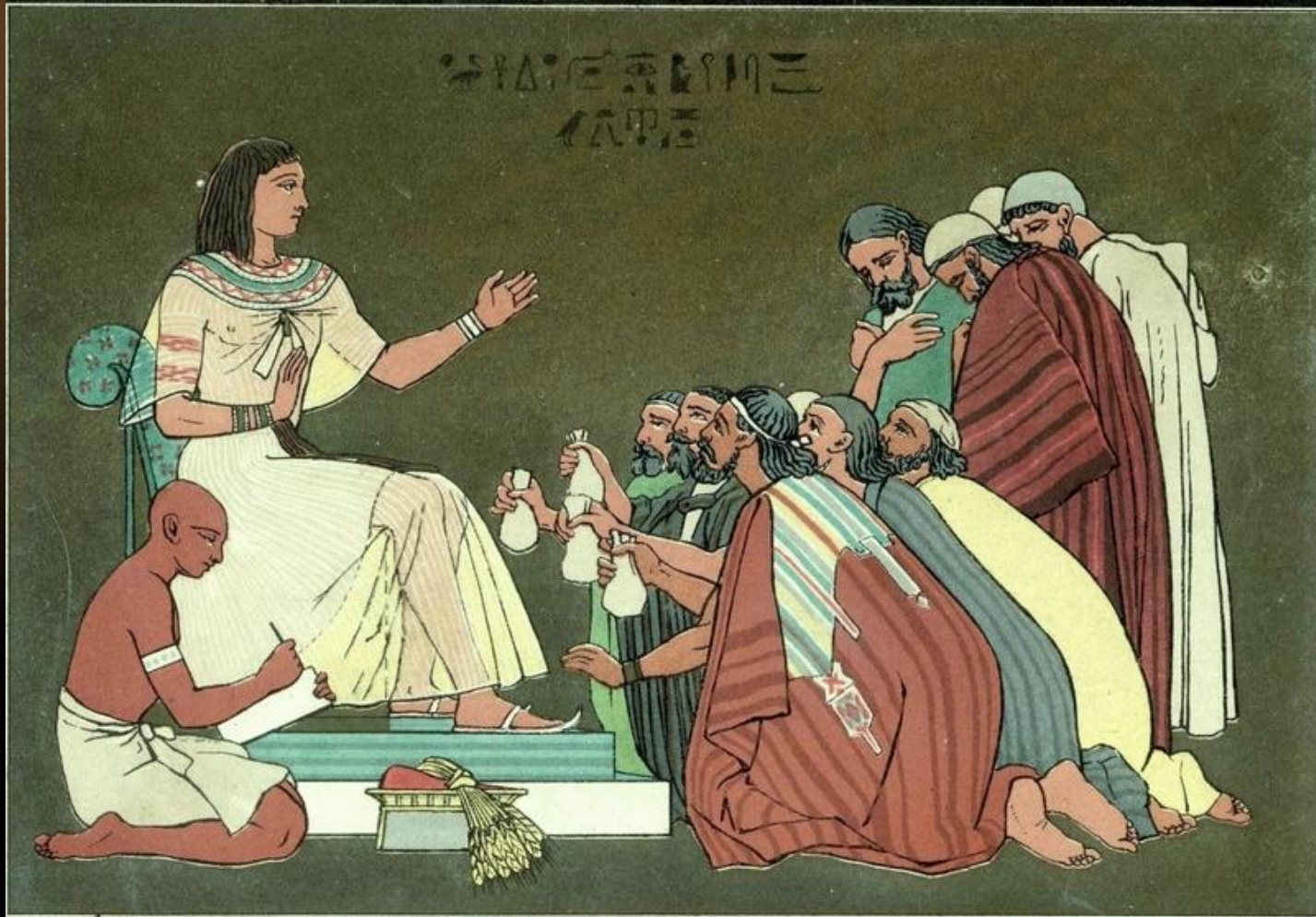
Butler & Baker Have Dreams – Interpreted by Joseph (*Genesis 40*)



Pharoah Has Dreams – Joseph Interprets & Promoted (*Genesis 41*)



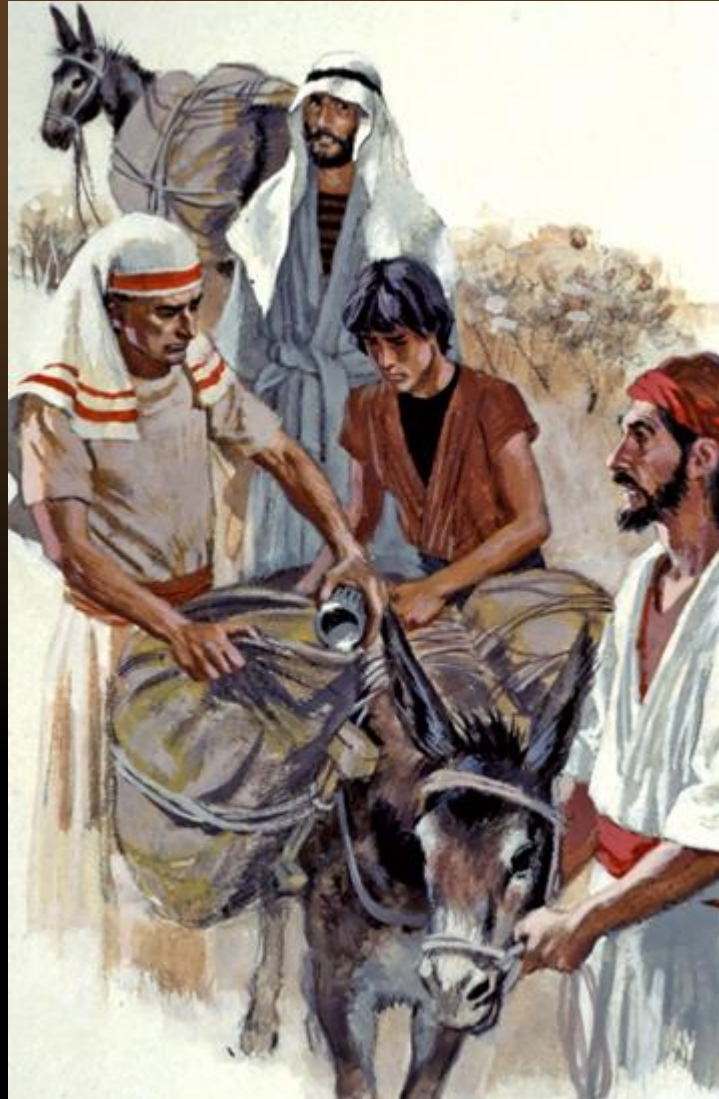
