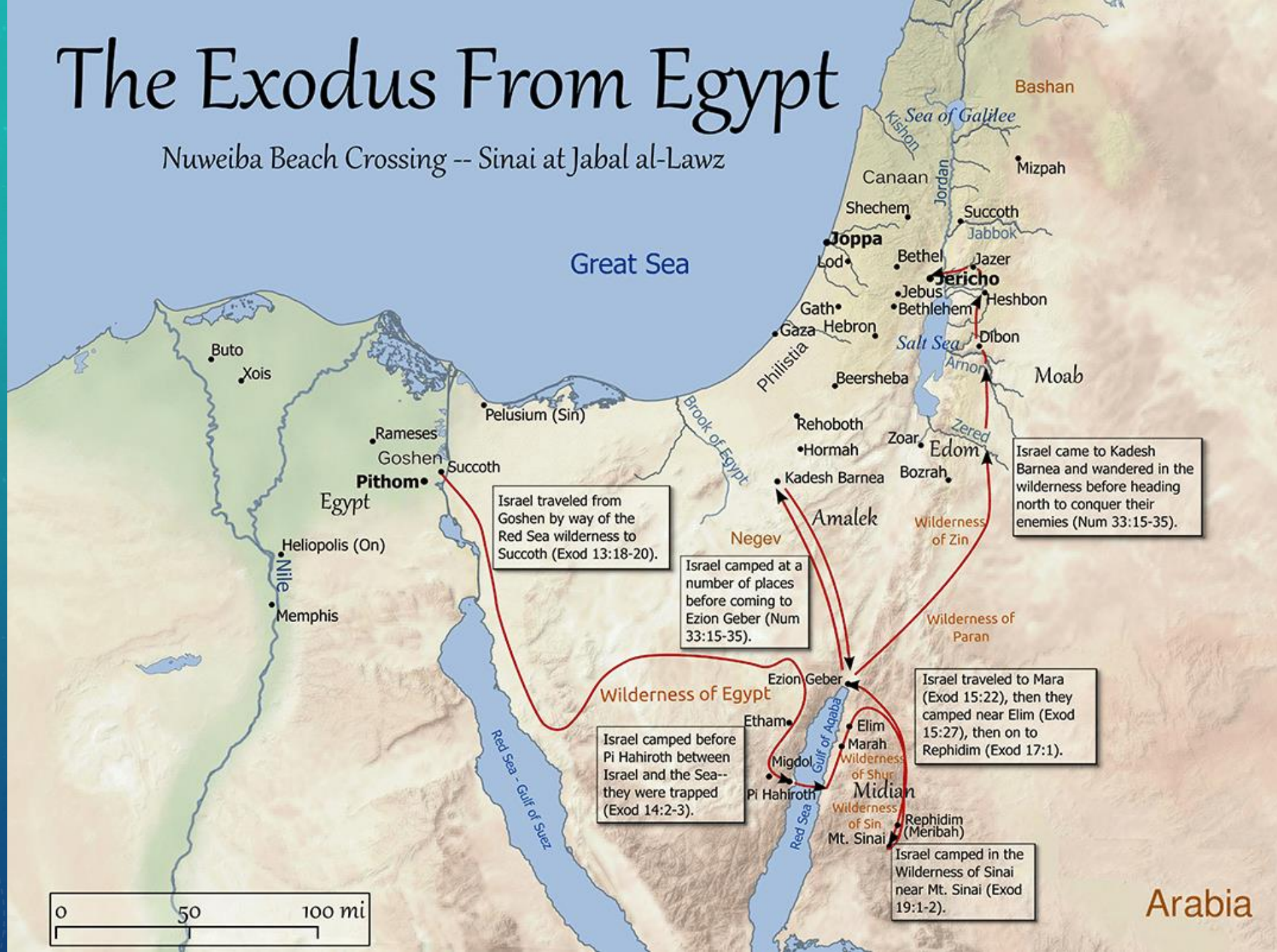

- Oholiab and Bezalel called by name and given special abilities by God
- Able men given abilities so that all of the work may be completed
- Reminder that God's people are to keep the Sabbath, and why
- Moses receives two tablets of stone written by the finger of God

• Chapter 32

- Moses is delayed, so Israel wants gods to worship
- Aaron fashions a golden calf from the earrings of the people
- “These are your gods, O Israel, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt”
- Moses implores God to not destroy the people
- Moses returns and, angered by the sins of the people, breaks the tablets
- Aaron’s excuse
- The sons of Levi take vengeance, killing about 3000

• Chapter 33

- God tells Moses to lead the people out of Sinai to the land of promise
- God says an angel will lead them, but He will not be with them
- Israel mourns this disastrous word
- The tent of meeting where Moses intervenes for the people
- Moses wants to see God's glory

• Chapter 34

- Moses cuts two tablets of stone and returns to the top of Mt. Sinai
- God passes before him and he worships
- Moses again intercedes for the people that God may forgive them
- God repeats His covenant with the people and gives instructions about what they are to do in the promised land
