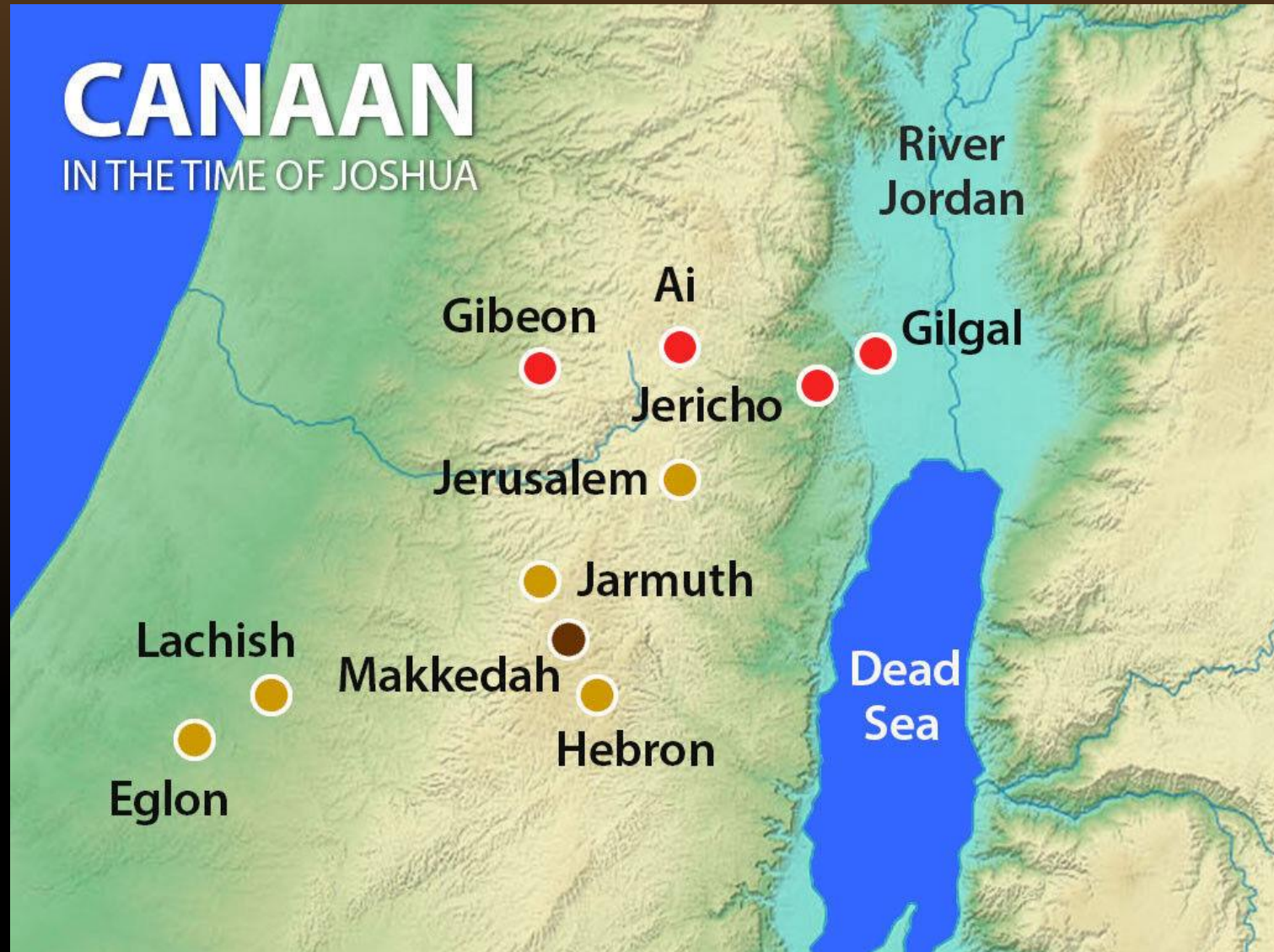

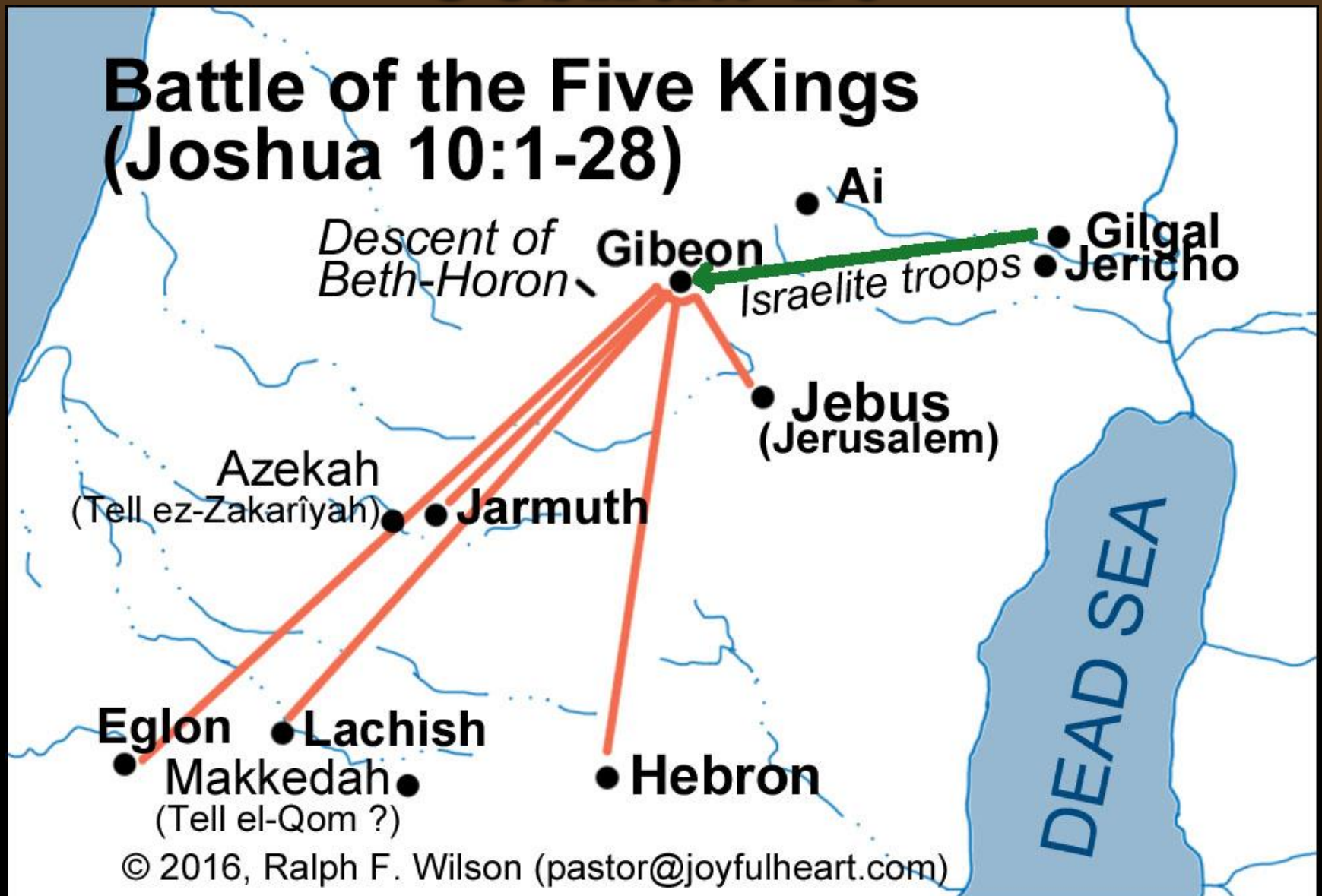

Battle of the Five Kings (Joshua 10:1-28)

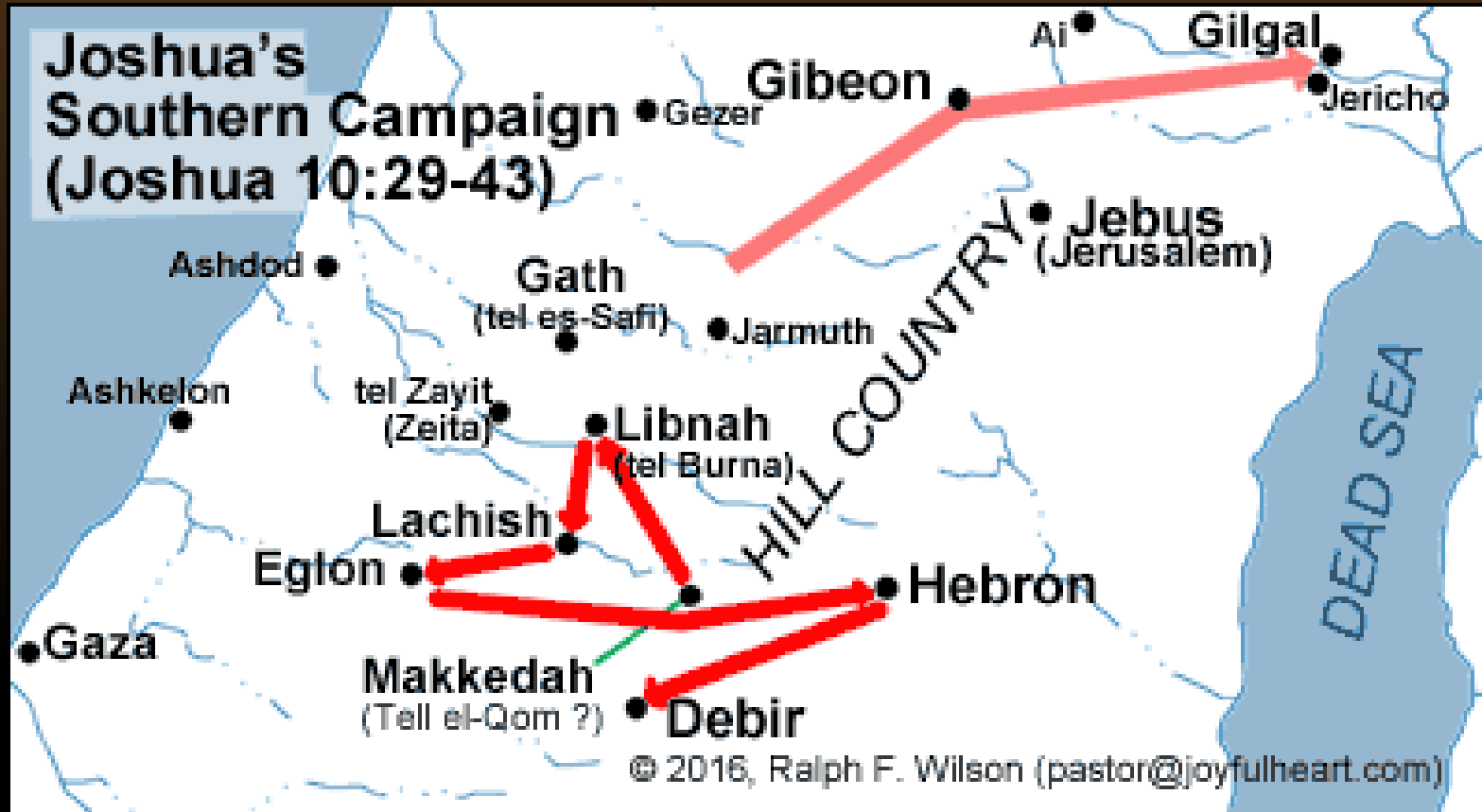

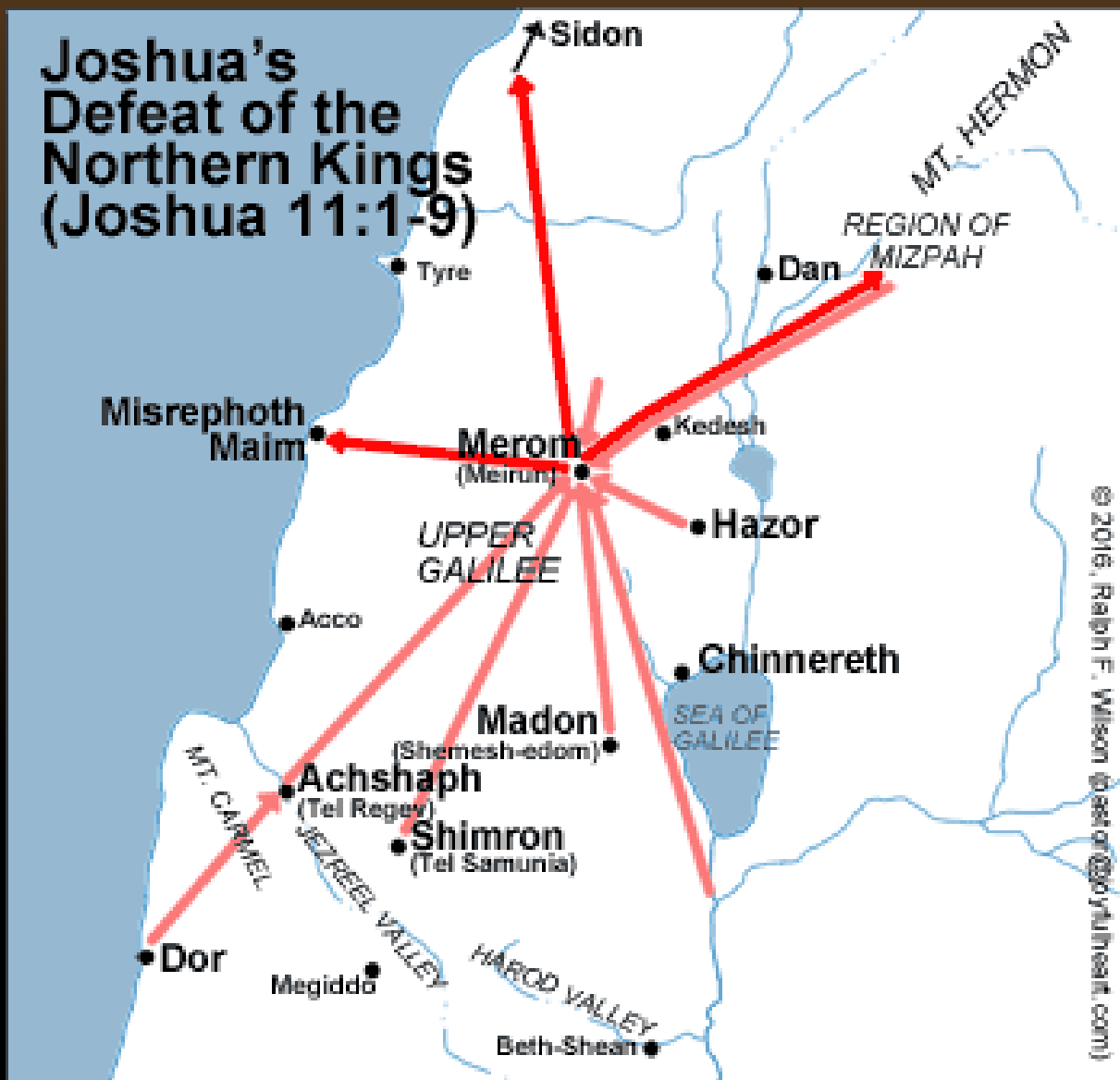
