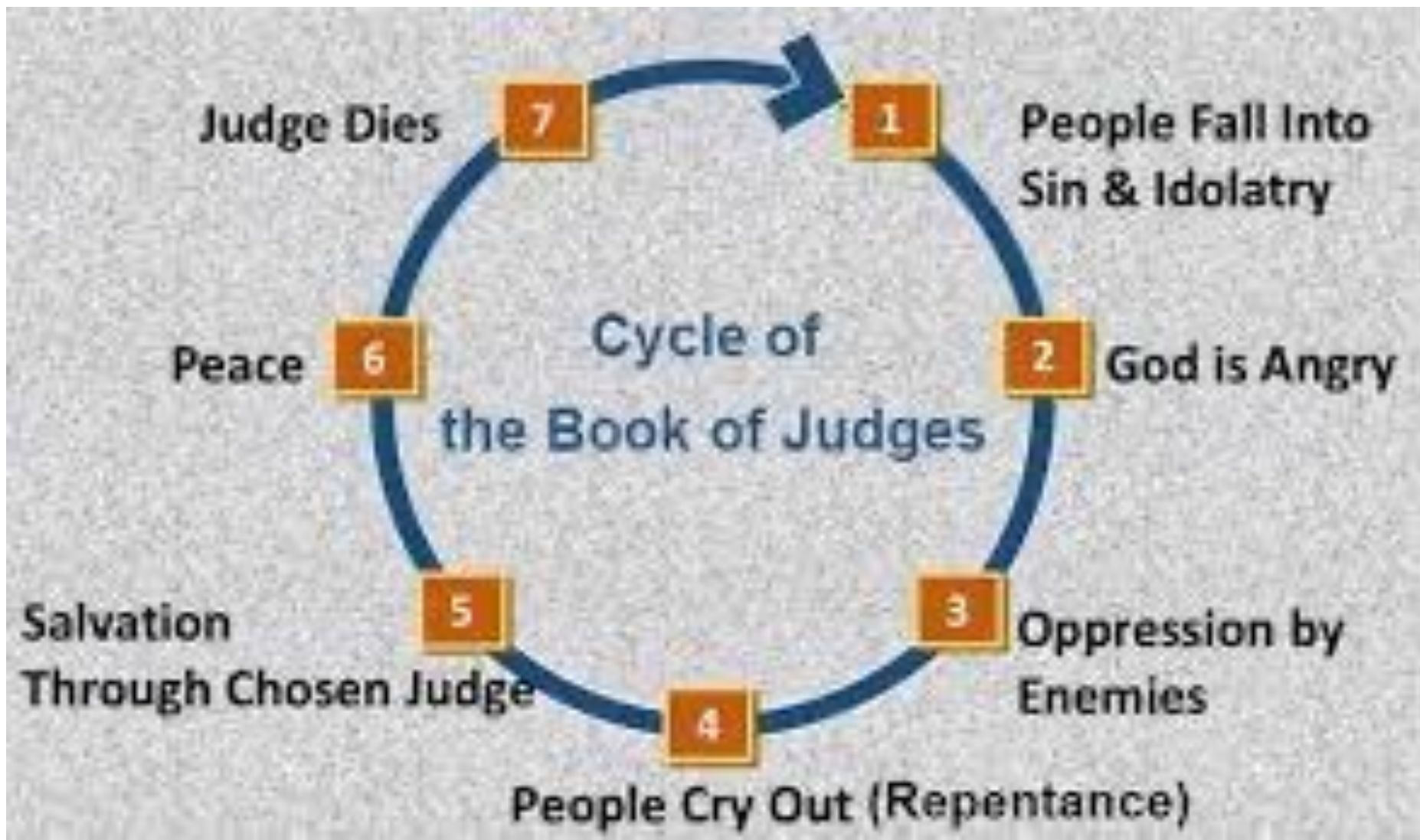

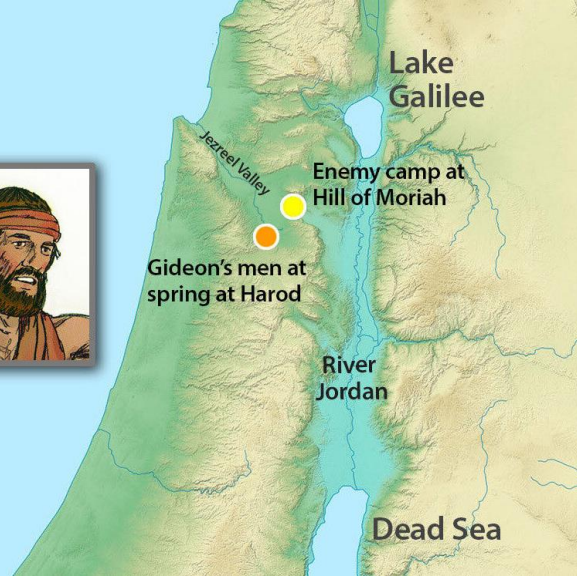
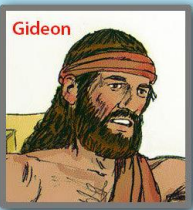

CHART 7: THE JUDGES OF ISRAEL

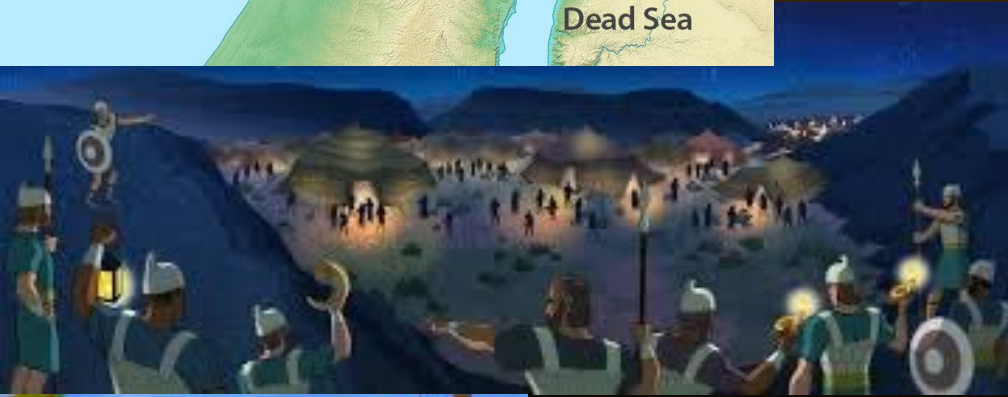
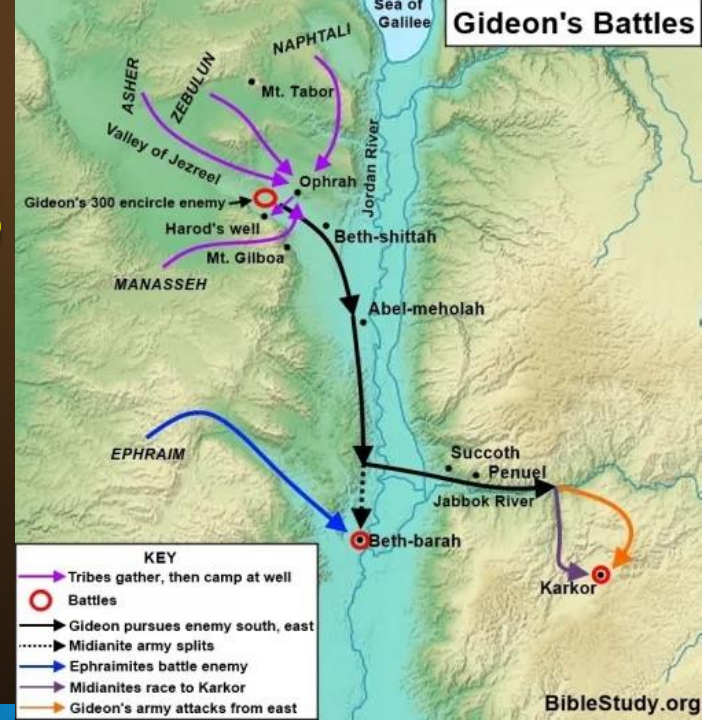

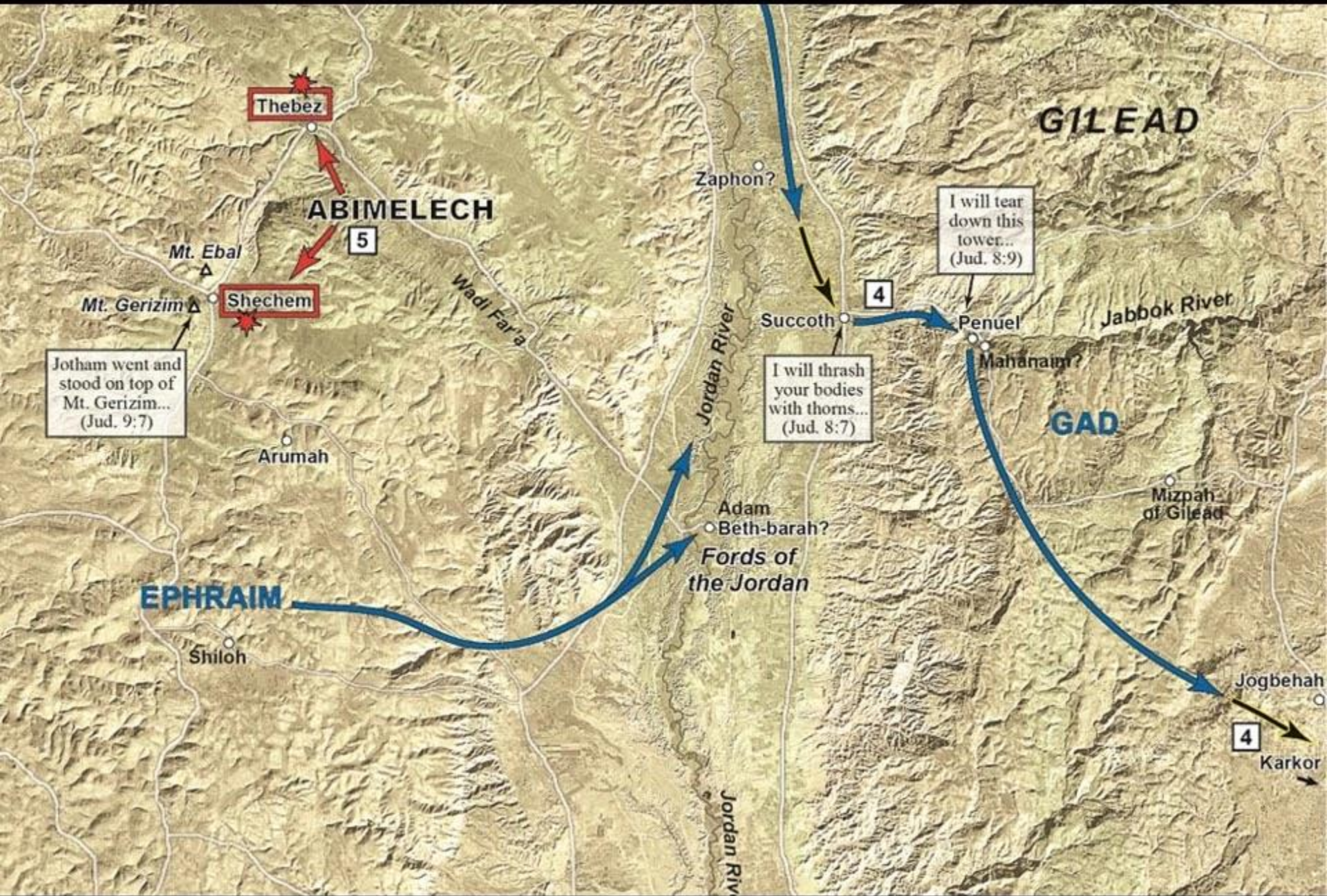

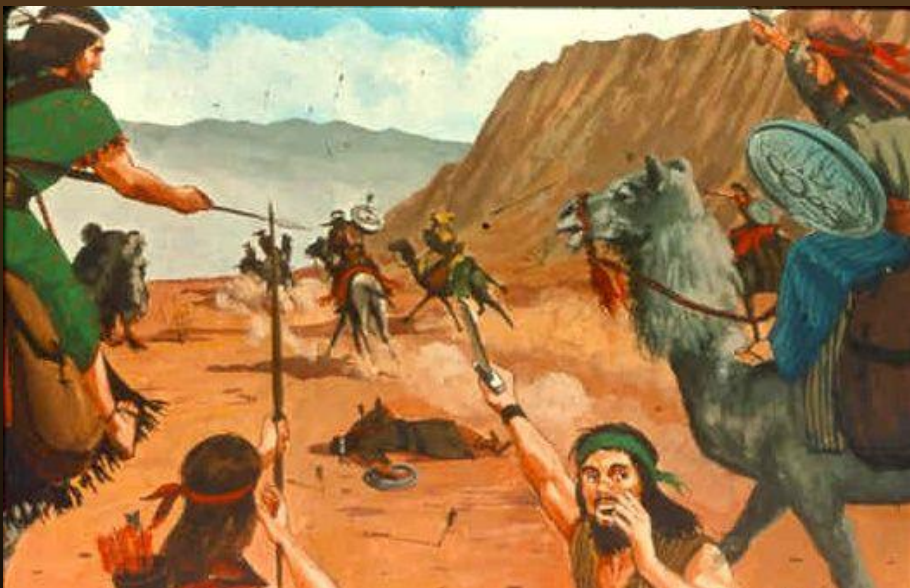
Gideon went up by the way of tent dwellers on the east of Nobah and Jogbehah

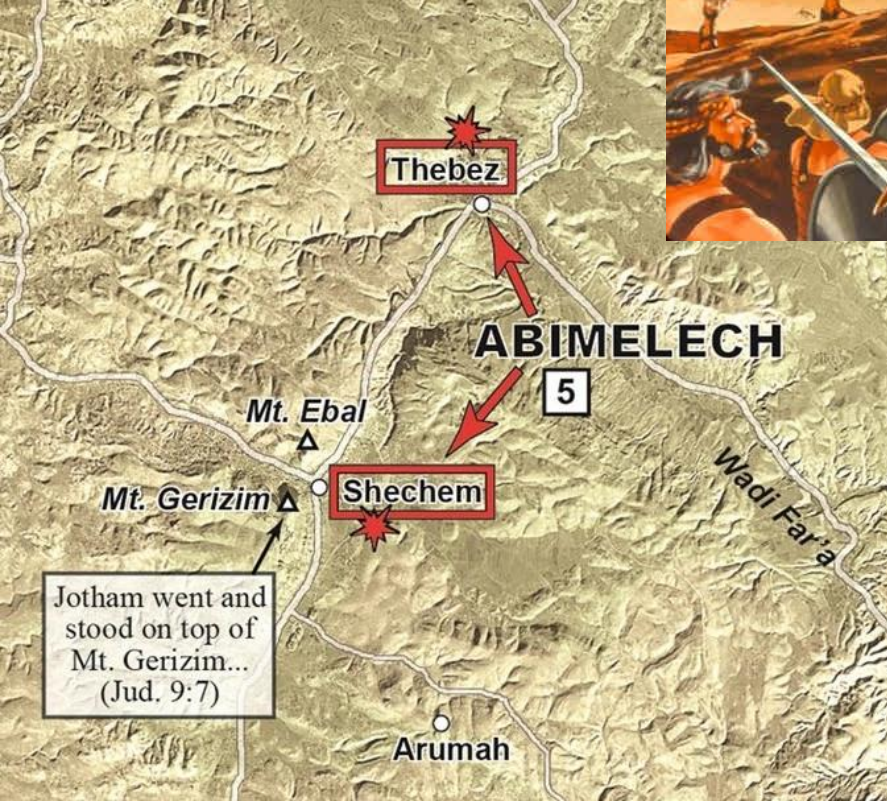
