 - i. But against principalities, powers. (v. 12b)
 - ii. Against the rulers of the darkness of this age. (v. 12c)
 - iii. Against spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places. (v. 12d)
 - d. Take up the whole armor of God. (v. 13a)
 - i. To be able to withstand in the evil day. (v. 13b)
 - ii. And having done all, to stand. (v. 13c)

 - i. Waist girded with truth. (v. 14a)
 - ii. Breastplate of righteousness. (v. 14b)
 - iii. Feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace. (v. 15)
 - iv. Shield of faith to quench the fiery darts of the wicked one. (v. 16)
 - v. Helmet of salvation. (v. 17a)
 - vi. Sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God. (v. 17b)

 - i. With prayer and supplication in the Spirit. (v. 18a)
 - ii. Being watchful with perseverance and supplication for the saints. (v. 18b)
 - 1. And for me, to boldly make known the gospel for which I am an ambassador in chains. (vv. 19-20a)
 - 2. That I may speak boldly, as I ought. (v. 20b)

 - A. Tychicus and His Report (vv. 21-22)
 - a. Tychicus will make my affairs and condition known to you.
(v. 21)
 - b. I have sent him for this very purpose, that you may find
comfort. (v. 22)
 - B. Wishes of Peace, Love, and Grace (vv. 23-24)
 - a. Peace, and love with faith, from God and Jesus. (v. 23)
 - b. Grace be with those who sincerely love the Lord. (v. 24)
