# The Seal of the Spirit

- ▶ <u>Seal</u>: sphragis 4973 Noun
- ▶ **Sealed**: sphragizo 4972 Verb
  - o the impression made by a signet, mark
  - that which confirms or authenticates, attestation, confirmation, certification,

# The Impression and Authentication of the Holy Spirit

- ▶ Seal the impression or mark
  - ► (Ezek.9:4)
  - ► (2Tim.2:19-26)
  - ▶ (Rom.4:11)
- Authentication or attestation (i.e. ownership)
  - ► (Rom.4:11) "sign" semeion: "a sign or distinguishing mark whereby something is known"

# The <u>Impression</u> and <u>Authentication</u> of the Holy Spirit

- ▶ The impression or "mark" of the Spirit
  - ▶ The Fruit of the Spirit (Gal.5:22-23)
  - ► Renewal (Titus 3:5)
  - ► Transformation (Rom.12:2) (2Cor.3:18)
- ► The Authentication or attestation of the Spirit
  - ▶ Sons and heirs (Rom.8:14-17) (1Jn.3:6-10)

## Our Spiritual Transformation

- ▶ The work of the Spirit
- ▶ The seal of sonship





- Strongs: 728. ἀρραβών arrhabon;
  - ▶ of Hebrew origin (h6162); a pledge, i.e. part of the purchase-money or property given in advance as security for the rest: earnest



#### ▶ BDAG:

 payment of part of a purchase price in advance, first installment, deposit, down payment, pledge



- Our inheritance is a metaphorical "mansion" (a glorified body) that will "house" our glorified spirit (Jn.14:1-2)
  - o (2Cor.4:16 5:6) (Heb.9:15) (1Pet.1:3-4)
  - Resurrected glory (1 Cor. 15:47-58)
  - Note the connection (2Cor.1:22; 3:18; 4:16-18; 5:1-8) esp. 5:5

So how is the transformation of my spirit (the seal of the Spirit) a guarantee, earnest or pledge of a glorified body?

▶ If God can transform my spirit so radically, powerfully and gloriously, that it can be conformed to the image of His Son, then I can be assured that He can and will transform my lowly body that it may be conformed to His glorious body!

o (2Cor.3:18) (Phil.3:20-21) (1Jn.3:1-3)

  - o "Firstfruits" of the Spirit (Rom.8:23)

### <u>Earnest</u>

- resulting from or showing sincere and intense conviction.
- a thing intended or regarded as a sign or promise of what is to come

## **Firstfruit**

- The first harvest or first portion of a thing to come
- The first harvest indicated and assured the harvest to follow

## Our Transformation

- The work of the Spirit in the new birth (Jn.3:5)
- The "seal" (mark and authentication) of sonship (Rom.8:14-17)
- ► The "guarantee" of an eternal, glorified body to house our eternal, glorified spirit (2Cor.5:1-6)
