- God brings the plague of frogs. The magicians of Egypt were able to duplicate it
- Pharaoh pleads for relief from the frogs and God causes the frogs to die
- The third plague could be lice, fleas or gnats, based on the Hebrew word kinnim
- God brings the fourth plague, swarms of flies
- Pharaoh hardens his heart and reneges on his agreement every time

- The fifth plague causes the Egyptian livestock to die
- The sixth plague brings boils on man and beast
- The seventh plague is hail. God issues a warning to bring man and beast inside
- The thunder, hail and fire strike down crops, trees, man and beast
- Pharaoh says "I have sinned". The hail ceases, but Pharaoh reneges again

- The eighth plague is locusts. Everything green that is left is destroyed
- Pharaoh pleads for the plague to end
- Gods sends a strong wind that carries every locust into the Red Sea
- The ninth plague was darkness to Egypt, but the people of Israel had light
- Pharaoh offers a limited release compromise, but Moses rejects it

- God tells Moses about the last plague
- With God's help, spoils are collected
- The death of every firstborn is foretold and described
- The reaction of the Egyptians is foretold
- Pharaoh again does not let God's people go
