- 1 Samuel 15 – Saul's disobedience

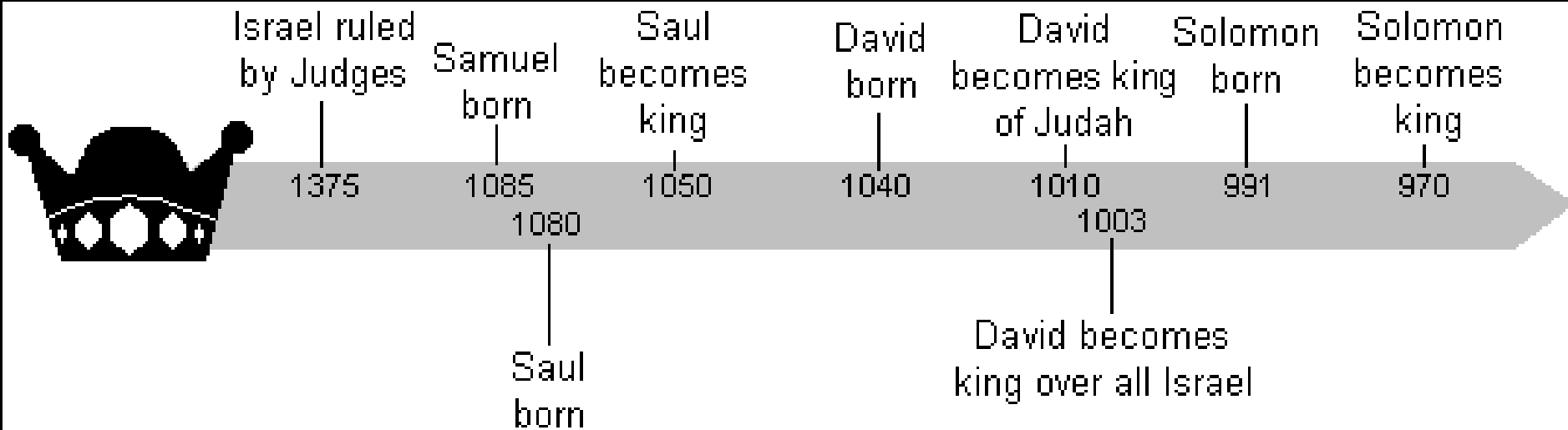
Overview of the Text

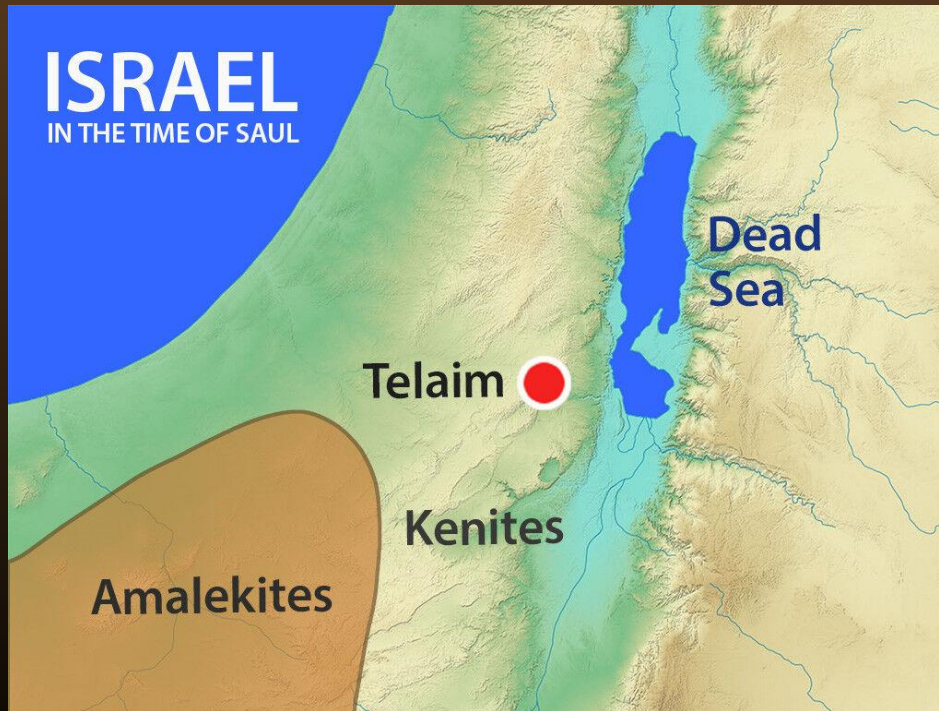

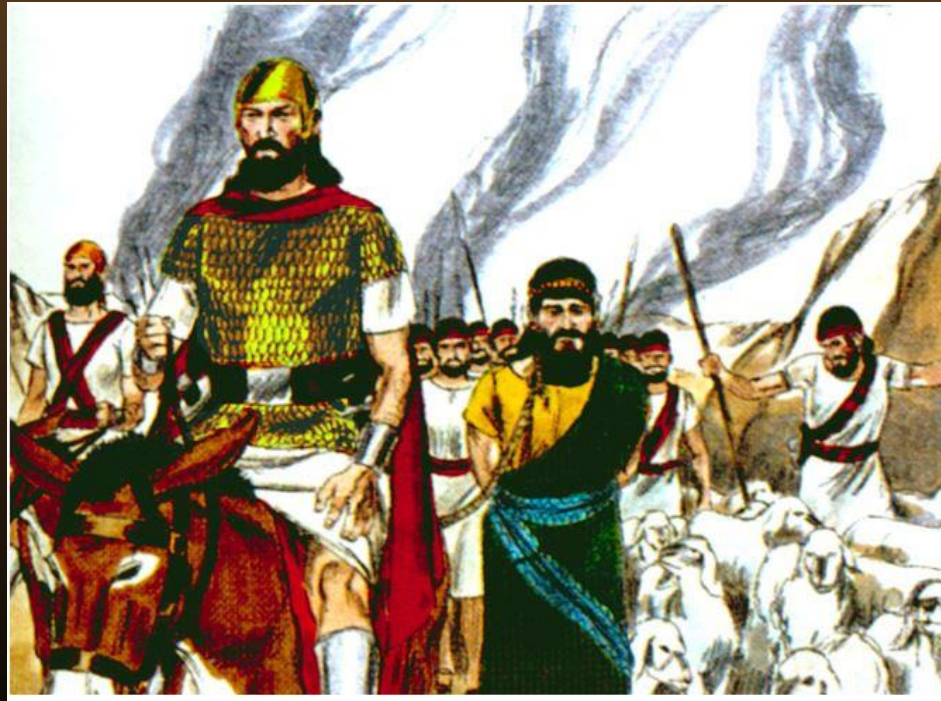
